PRESS RELEASE - April 6, 2017

- Misdemeanor - Operating on Suspended License (3rd Offense):** On Saturday, April 1, 2017, at 4:16 PM, Patrolman Ryan Donohue arrested **Alexandra R. Lepore-Thompson**, age 45, of 500 Kingstown Road, Apartment 3A, Richmond on a charge of **Operating on a Suspended License (3rd or subsequent suspended license violation)**, after a stop of her vehicle on Kingstown Road revealed that her Massachusetts license had been suspended and she had five prior suspended license violations. She was processed at the station, and was released with a summons to appear on April 27, 2017, in 4th District Court for arraignment.
- Misdemeanor - DUI (1st offense - BAC .10 - .15):** On Sunday, April 2, 2017, at approximately 1:46 AM, Corporal William Litterio arrested **Robert A. Lilligren**, age 51, of 123 Kuehn Road, Ashaway on a charge of **Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and/ or Drugs (1st offense - BAC .10-.15)**, after a Good Samaritan reported that they were following an erratic operator along Richmond Townhouse Road. Corporal Litterio located and stopped the suspect vehicle. The operator, Mr. Lilligren, was arrested on suspicion of DUI after performing a series of standard field sobriety tests. He submitted to a Breathalyzer test that resulted in BAC (blood-alcohol-content) readings of **.133 (1st phase)**, and **.126 (2nd phase)**. He was processed at the station, and was released with a summons to appear in 4th District Court for arraignment on the above charge.
- Wayward Juvenile - Disorderly Conduct:** On Sunday, April 2nd, 2017, at 1:50PM, Patrolmen Brock Taylor and Jeff Vaughn arrested a **16-year-old male resident of Richmond** on a charge **Disorderly Conduct** after officers were dispatched to investigate a report of a youth who was throwing rocks at a vehicle parked in his driveway and was threatening others. Upon arrival, officers observed broken glass windows and dents on a vehicle deliberately caused by the youth. The owner of the vehicle did not wish to pursue charges, but the youth refused to calm down and continued to engage in tumultuous behavior. He was subsequently transported to Westerly Hospital for an evaluation. He shall be petitioned into Family Court on that charge.

4. **Misdemeanor - Operating on Suspended License (3rd Offense):** On Sunday, April 2, 2017, at 4:35 PM, Patrolman Michael Jacome arrested **Alyssa M. Goldberg**, age 28, of 16 S. Joseph Street, Westerly on a charge of **Operating on a Suspended License (3rd or subsequent suspended license violation)**, after stopping her vehicle on Main Street when he observed she was not wearing her seatbelt. The stop revealed that her driver's license had been suspended on 12/28/16 for *Failure to Maintain Financial Responsibility*. This instance constituted her third suspended license driving violation. She was processed at the station, and was released with a summons to appear in 4th District Court for arraignment.
5. **Misdemeanor - Domestic Simple Assault:** On Sunday, April 2nd, 2017 at approximately 7:15 PM, Patrolman Daniel Kelley arrested **Philip B. Derocher**, age 35, of 56 Epworth Avenue, West Warwick on a charge of **Domestic Simple Assault** after he responded to the station to turn himself in relative to an alleged domestic incident on April 1st at 261 Richmond Townhouse Road. The arrest was the result of an investigation by Officers Kelley, Anthony Zoglio, and Ryan Donohue who responded to the above address a day earlier for a "9-1-1 hang-up call." Mr. Derocher was processed at the station, and was arraigned before Justice of the Peace Joseph Scott. He was released on personal recognizance and was issued a no-contact order barring him from contact with his alleged victim.
6. **Misdemeanor - DUI (1st offense - BAC greater than .15):** On Sunday, April 2, 2017, at approximately 10:57 PM, Patrolman Michael Jacome arrested **Nicole A. Greene**, age 31, of 38 K G Ranch Road, Richmond on a charge of **Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and/ or Drugs (1st offense - BAC greater than .15)**, after a responding to the area of Cumberland Farms on Main Street for a reported drunk driver. Off. Jacome located the vehicle on Main Street and followed it onto Nooseneck Hill Road where he observed the operator repeatedly drift towards the shoulder of the road over the white fog line. He conducted a motor vehicle stop on Nooseneck Hill Road. The operator, Nicole Greene, was arrested on suspicion of DUI after performing a series of standard field sobriety tests. She submitted to a Breathalyzer test that resulted in BAC (blood-alcohol-content) readings of **.160 (1st phase)**, and **.152 (2nd phase)**. She was processed at the station, and was arraigned before Justice of the Peace Joseph Scott before being released on \$1,000 personal recognizance.
7. **Misdemeanor - Obstructing a Police Officer in Execution of their Duty:** On Sunday, April 2, 2017, at approximately 10:57 PM, Patrolman Andy Briody arrested **Derek L. Greene**, age 29, of 38 K G Ranch Road, Richmond on a charge of **Obstruction of a Police Officer in Execution of their Duty** after he repeatedly ignored Officer Briody's commands to remain in a vehicle that had been stopped for erratic operation. He was processed at the station and was released with a summons to appear in 4th District Court for arraignment on April 13th, 2017.
