PRESS RELEASE - December 15, 2016

- WAYWARD Juvenile - Simple Assault/Battery & Disorderly Conduct:** On Wednesday, December 7, 2016, at approximately 6:00 PM, Patrolman Anthony Zoglio arrested a **12-year-old juvenile male resident of Richmond** on charges of (1) **Simple Assault & Battery**, and (2) **Disorderly Conduct** after a parent filed a complaint that her 13-year-old son had been the victim of an unprovoked assault after he stepped off the school bus at the Chariho Shopping Plaza on December 5th, 2016, resulting in minor facial injuries. Investigation revealed that two boys, ages 12 and 13, surprised the victim as he walked away from the school bus by grabbing him from behind to hold his arms back while both boys punched him in the face. The assailants claimed they had heard rumors that the victim said negative things about them. The youth shall be petitioned into Family Court on the above charges.

- Bench Warrant: Failure to Appear on Felony Charges filed by Richmond PD:** On Tuesday, December 13, 2016, at approximately 2:20 PM, Detective Drew Bishop arrested **Laura Rodriguez**, age 20, of 3225 80th, Apt. 11370, East Elmhurst, NY on the strength of an **outstanding Superior Court Bench Warrant** that had been issued on August 23, 2016, for **Failure to Appear - Arraignment** on charges of **Passing a Counterfeit Bill (\$100) and Conspiracy** (Richmond PD). The charges stem from a joint investigation by Corporal William Litterio, Patrolman Dan Kelley, and Detective Bishop, along with the Rhode Island State Police, US Secret Service, and Hopkinton Police

Department, after several businesses in Richmond were targeted by a group of suspects presenting counterfeit \$100 bills in exchange for merchandise back on March 21st, 2016. Investigation revealed that Ms. Rodriguez had presented a counterfeit \$100 bill to the CVS on Main Street in Wyoming. The case was presented to RI Department of Attorney General, which led to the above charges. Ms. Rodriguez turned herself in at the Richmond Police Department on December 13th, and was processed at the station. She was subsequently arraigned in Washington County Superior Court, and was released on personal recognizance.

4. **Misdemeanor - Domestic Disorderly Conduct & Resisting Arrest:**

On Wednesday, December 14th, 2016 at approximately at 12:25 AM, Patrolmen Michael Jacome and Chris Lyman arrested **Katrina Oliver**, age 47, of 59 Waterside Drive, Apt. D, Wildwood, MO, on charges of (1) **Domestic Disorderly Conduct**, and (2) **Resisting Arrest** after officers were dispatched to a residence on Job Drive for in reference to a "9-1-1" caller reporting a domestic disturbance in progress. After Officers completed their scene investigation, and informed Ms. Oliver that she was being arrested, she actively resisted arrest and refused to cooperate. She was returned to the station, where she was processed and held overnight for arraignment in 4th District Court. On December 14th, 2016, she was arraigned on the above charges, and was released on personal recognizance, and the court issued her a no-contact order.
