PRESS RELEASE - February 16, 2017

1. **Wayward Juvenile - Disorderly Conduct:** On Wednesday, February 8, 2017, at approximately 4:53 PM, Patrolmen Jeff Vaughn and Anthony Zoglio responded to an address in Richmond at the request of a concerned parent who reported their teenage son was "out of control," and arrested a **16-year-old juvenile male** on a charge of **Disorderly Conduct** after he engaged in a violent profane outburst in his family's home, and refused to bring himself under control. The youth was processed at the station, and was later released to an approved guardian from another residence. The youth shall be petitioned into Family Court on the above charge.
2. **Bench Warrant:** On Friday, February 10, 2017, at 11:57 AM, Patrolmen Brock Taylor and Adam Andrukiewicz arrested **Susan Buerman**, age 49, of 198 Main Street, Hopkinton on the strength of an **outstanding 4th District Court Bench Warrant** that had been issued on March 3rd, 2016, for *Failure to Appear for Arraignment* on an original charge of *Operating on a Suspended License* (Richmond PD) after a motor vehicle stop on Route 95 Southbound at Exit 3B revealed the above warrant, and that she was driving an unregistered vehicle with a suspended driver's license (civil infractions). Mrs. Buerman was processed at the station, and was transported to 4th District Court relative to the above warrant.
3. **Affidavit/Arrest Warrant:** On Monday, February 13, 2017, at 12:21 PM, Patrolmen Andy Briody and Michael Jacome arrested **Timothy J. Adams**, age 22, of 24 Shadow Ridge Drive, Richmond on the strength of an **outstanding arrest warrant held by the Charlestown Police Department** charging him with *Simple Assault/Battery* and *Disorderly Conduct*. Officers received a request from the Charlestown Police to attempt to locate and arrest the subject, and officers located him inside a vehicle at the above address. He was processed at the station, and was subsequently turned over to the custody of the Charlestown PD.
