## PRESS RELEASE - February 7, 2017

---

1. **Misdemeanor - Unlawful Appropriation (Under \$1000):** On Friday, February 3, 2017, at approximately 2:46 PM, Patrolman Michael Jacome arrested **Mitchell B. Stone**, age 18, of 18 Teaberry Lane, Hopkinton, RI after he turned himself in on the strength of an outstanding affidavit/arrest warrant held by the Richmond Police Department charging him with one misdemeanor count of **Unlawful Appropriation (Apple MacBook Air laptop valued at approximately \$915)**. The charge stems from an investigation by School Resource Officer Adam Andrukiewicz into complaint filed by the school administration after Mr. Stone was entrusted with the above computer as a student, but then retained possession of it and failed to return it despite not returning as a student. The administration's attempts to notify and contact Mr. Stone reportedly went unanswered. He was processed at the station and was subsequently released with a summons to appear in 4<sup>th</sup> District Court on February 23, 2017, for arraignment on the above charge.
2. **Misdemeanor - Domestic Disorderly Conduct:** On Saturday, February 4, 2017 at approximately at 11:16 AM, Sergeant Michael Lawing and Lieutenant John Arnold arrested **Deborah Moorehead**, age 58, of 124 Switch Road, Richmond on a charge of **Domestic Disorderly Conduct** after officers were dispatched to a reported domestic disturbance in progress at the above address. She was processed at the station, and was arraigned before Justice of the Peace Joseph Scott. She was released on \$1,000 personal recognizance and was issued a no-contact order barring her from her alleged victim.
3. **Misdemeanor - Domestic Disorderly Conduct & Domestic Refusal to Relinquish Telephone:** On Saturday, February 4, 2017 at approximately at 11:16 AM, Sergeant Michael Lawing and Lieutenant John Arnold arrested **Gerald R. Moorehead**, age 60, of 124 Switch Road, Richmond on charges of (1) **Domestic Disorderly Conduct** and (2) **Domestic Refusal to Relinquish Telephone** after officers were dispatched to a reported domestic disturbance in progress at the above address. He was processed at the station, and was arraigned before Justice of the Peace Joseph Scott. He was released on \$2,000 personal recognizance and was issued a no-contact order barring him from his alleged victim.

4. **Misdemeanor -Domestic Simple Assault & Domestic Disorderly Conduct:** On Saturday, February 4, 2017 at approximately at 7:27 PM, Patrolmen Ryan Donohue and Jeff Vaughn arrested **Ralph R. Migliaccio**, age 51, of 34 KG Ranch Road, Hope Valley on charges of (1) **Domestic Simple Assault/Battery** and (2) **Domestic Disorderly Conduct** after officers were dispatched to a reported domestic disturbance in progress at the above address. Investigation at the scene revealed that Mr. Migliaccio had allegedly thrown a space heater at a household member during an argument, which left a visible bruise on the victim's body. He was processed at the station, and was arraigned before Justice of the Peace Joseph Scott. He was released on \$1,000 personal recognizance and was issued a no-contact order barring him from his alleged victim.
5. **Misdemeanor -Domestic Simple Assault / Disorderly Conduct / Vandalism / Refusal to Relinquish Telephone:** On Saturday, February 5, 2017 at approximately at 1:54 PM, Sergeant Michael Lawing and Detective Drew Bishop arrested **James Paquette**, age 21, of 32 Sunset Drive, Richmond on charges of (1) **Domestic Simple Assault/Battery**, (2) **Domestic Disorderly Conduct**, (3) **Domestic Vandalism**, and (4) **Domestic Refusal to Relinquish Telephone**, after officers were dispatched to a reported domestic disturbance in progress at the above address. Investigation at the scene revealed that Mr. Paquette had allegedly pushed a victim to the ground and spat on them during an argument. When the alleged victim went to a bedroom and locked the door, Mr. Paquette allegedly kicked in the door, and then attempted to take a telephone away from the victim while they were reporting the domestic to the Richmond Police Department via 9-1-1. Mr. Paquette was processed at the station and arraigned before Justice of the Peace Joseph Scott. He was released on \$2,000 personal recognizance and was issued a no-contact order barring him from his alleged victim.
6. **Bench Warrants & Operating on a Foreign License While under Suspension:** On Sunday, February 5, 2017, at 8:09 PM, Patrolman Ryan Donohue arrested **Thomas MacLean**, age 51, of 20024 NE Marie Avenue, Blounstown, FL on a charge of **Operating on a Foreign License (FL) While Under RI License Suspension**, and on the strength of an **outstanding 3<sup>rd</sup> District Court Bench Warrant** that had been issued on November 19, 1984, for *Failure to Pay Court Fine* (East Greenwich PD), and on **Superior Court Full Bench Warrant** that had been issued on March 11, 1985, for *Violation Probation* (Cranston PD). The arrest was the result of a motor vehicle stop on Kingstown Road. Mr. MacLean was processed at the station, and was held overnight pending his appearance in 4<sup>th</sup> District Court the following morning on the above warrants.
7. **Bench Warrant:** On Monday, February 6, 2017, at 12:21 PM, Detective Drew Bishop arrested **Adam T. Silvia**, age 30, of 25 Canterbury Drive, Westerly on the strength of an **outstanding arrest warrant held by the Narragansett Police Department** charging him with *Simple Assault/Battery*. Det. Bishop had stopped Mr. Silvia for speeding on Shannock Hill Road, which revealed the above warrant. He was processed at the station, and was subsequently turned over to the custody of the Narragansett PD.
