PRESS RELEASE - January 19, 2017

- Bench Warrant:** On Wednesday, January 12, 2017, at approximately 10:00 PM, Patrolmen Ryan Donohue and Jeff Vaughn arrested **Matthew Sherman**, age 22, of 4 Debra Drive, Richmond on the strength of an **outstanding 4th District Court Bench Warrant** that had been issued on December 30, 2016, for *Failure to Appear/Pay* on an original charge of *Operating on a Suspended License* (Richmond PD). Mr. Sherman was processed at the station, and was subsequently arraigned before Justice of the Peace James Callaghan. He was released after posting the requisite cash bail of \$492.
- Misdemeanor - Reckless Driving:** On Tuesday, January 17, 2017 at approximately 6:45 PM, Patrolman Ryan Donohue arrested **Cody J. Moorehead**, age 23, of 124 Switch Road, Hope Valle on a charge **Reckless Driving**, after Mr. Moorehead accelerated away from the officer when he attempted to stop his vehicle on South County Trail. Mr. Moorehead turned abruptly onto Kenyon School Road at a high rate of speed, and lost control of his vehicle at the intersection with Lewiston Avenue. He was processed at the station, and was released with a summons to appear in 4th District Court on February 16, 2017, for arraignment on the above charge.
- WAYWARD Juvenile - Disorderly Conduct:** On Wednesday, January 18, 2017, at approximately 10:04 AM, School Resource officer Adam Andrukiewicz arrested **a 17-year-old juvenile male** student of the Chariho High School after the youth engaged in a loud and profane verbal outburst in class, which was disruptive. After being removed from class, he continued the behavior with a school dean and the SRO. The youth was returned to the police station, and was released to his father. The youth shall be petitioned into Family Court on the above charge.
- Misdemeanor - Operating on Suspended License (3rd Offense):** On Thursday, January 19, 2017, at 4:00 PM, Patrolman Ryan Donohue arrested **Joshua I. Boutros**, age 24, of 110 East Pasquisett Trail, Charlestown on a charge of **Operating on a Suspended License (3rd suspended license violation)**, after a motor vehicle stop on South County Trail revealed that his license had been suspended on October 4, 2016 for *Failure to Appear/Pay*. Mr. Boutros was also cited for having open containers of alcoholic beverages (vodka) present while driving a vehicle. He was processed at the station, and was released with a summons to appear in 4th District Court on February 16, 2017 for arraignment.

5. **Misdemeanor - DUI (1st offense - BAC .10 - 15):** On Friday, January 20, 2017, at approximately 1:02 AM, Patrolmen Brock Taylor and Michael Jacome arrested **Kellie L. Barnes**, age 22, of 4043-B Old Post Road, Charlestown on a charge of **Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and/ or Drugs (1st offense - BAC .10-.15)**, after a motor vehicle stop on Route 95 Northbound that stemmed from a speeding violation on Kingstown Road. Ms. Barnes was arrested on suspicion of DUI after performing a series of standard field sobriety tests. She submitted to a Breathalyzer test that resulted in BAC (blood-alcohol-content) readings of **.130 (1st phase)**, and **.130 (2nd phase)**. Additionally, she was cited with a civil violation for presence of an open alcoholic beverage while driving a motor vehicle. She was processed at the station and was arraigned before Justice of the Peace Michael Robinson. She was subsequently released on \$1,000 personal recognizance.
