PRESS RELEASE - January 3, 2017

- Misdemeanor - DUI (1st offense - BAC unknown), and Chemical Test Refusal:**
On Friday, December 23, 2016 at approximately 8:22 PM, Corporal William Litterio and Patrolman Andy Briody arrested **Mark A. Rich**, age 57, of 121 Birch Road, South Kingstown on a charge of (1) **Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and/ or Drugs (1st offense - BAC unknown)**, and (2) **Refusal to Submit to a Chemical Test (civil)**, after a Good Samaritan called to report an erratic operator who kept leaving the lane of travel on Kingstown Road, and nearly collided with a utility pole. Cpl. Litterio located Mr. Rich's vehicle on Kingstown Road at Stop & Shop. Mr. Rich was arrested on suspicion of DUI after performing a series of standard field sobriety tests. He was processed at the station, and was later released with a summons to appear in 4th District Court for arraignment on the above DUI charge.
- Misdemeanor - DUI (1st offense - BAC unknown), and Chemical Test Refusal:**
On Monday, December 26, 2016 at approximately 5:00 PM, Patrolmen Ryan Donohue and Michael Jacome arrested **Karli L. Morgan**, age 18, of 10 Big Rock Drive, Hopkinton on a charge of (1) **Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and/ or Drugs (1st offense - BAC unknown)**, and (2) **Refusal to Submit to a Chemical Test (civil)**, after officers were dispatched to an accident at 410 Kingstown Road where Ms. Morgan had lost control of her vehicle. She had been traveling westbound and crossed into the opposite (eastbound) lane and off the roadway crashing head-on into a tree. There were no serious injuries. Evidence at the scene led officers to suspect that the operator had smoked "Dabs" (Butane Hash Oil) and marijuana before the crash. Ms. Morgan was arrested on suspicion of DUI, and she subsequently refused to consent to a chemical test. She was released with a summons to appear in 4th District Court for arraignment on January 5, 2017, for the above DUI charge.
- WAYWARD Juvenile - Vandalism & Disorderly Conduct:** On Wednesday, December 28, 2016, at approximately 10:31 AM, Detective Drew Bishop arrested a **16-year-old juvenile male** student of the Chariho RYSE Program as the result of an investigation into an incident that occurred at school on December 22nd, 2016. Investigation revealed that the youth had punched out a glass window in anger, and struck a staff member with closed-fist punches in reaction to an administrative decision that he did not agree with. The youth shall be petitioned into Family Court on the above charge.

4. **Misdemeanor - DUI (1st offense - BAC .15 or greater):** On Wednesday, December 28, 2016 at approximately 2:13 PM, Sergeant Michael Lawing and Patrolman Anthony Zoglio arrested **William Comier**, age 63, of 825 Main Street, Apt. #205, Hopkinton on a charge of **Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and/ or Drugs (1st offense - BAC .15)**, after a Good Samaritan called 9-1-1 to report a possible drunk driver. Mr. Comier, who also had an expired driver's license, was stopped on Main Street and arrested on suspicion of DUI after performing a series of standard field sobriety tests. He submitted to a Breathalyzer test that resulted in BAC (blood-alcohol-content) readings of **.176 (1st phase)**, and **.161 (2nd phase)**. Mr. Comier was processed at the station and was released with a summons to appear in 4th District Court for arraignment on January 12, 2017, for the above DUI charge.
5. **Misdemeanor - DUI (1st offense - BAC unknown), and Chemical Test Refusal:** On Thursday, December 29, 2016 at approximately 7:36 PM, Corporal William Litterio and Patrolman Andy Briody arrested **Katrina Oliver**, age 47, of 59 Waterside Drive, Apt. #D, Wildwood, Missouri on a charge of (1) **Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and/ or Drugs (1st offense - BAC unknown)**, and (2) **Refusal to Submit to a Chemical Test (civil)**, after Cpl. Litterio encountered her vehicle on Hillsdale Road. The officer was traveling behind her in the southbound lane of travel as she was traveling below the posted speed limit at 5-MPH in a 25-MPH zone, and drifting across both lanes of travel. She then left the lane of travel, and collided head-on with a tree. Due to the low speed of her vehicle prior to the collision, she was not injured. She was arrested on suspicion of DUI based on probable cause, and subsequently refused to submit to a chemical test. She was processed at the station, and was arraigned on the DUI charge before Justice of the Peace Joseph Scott. She was subsequently released on \$2,000 personal recognizance.
6. **Misdemeanor - Throwing Articles at Moving Vehicle & Vandalism:** On Saturday, December 31, 2016 at approximately 6:09 PM, Patrolman Ryan Donohue arrested **Michael E. Pelrine**, age 56, of 37 Clearview Drive, North Kingstown on charges of (1) **Throwing Articles (wood) at a Moving Vehicle**, and (2) **Vandalism**, after an investigation into a complaint by a motorist and passenger who were traveling on Susan Drive when they allegedly observed Mr. Pelrine throw a "chunk of wood" at the passenger's side of their vehicle as they passed by. The impact caused damage to the exterior of their vehicle. Mr. Pelrine allegedly told the complainant at the scene that he felt the motorist was driving too fast through the neighborhood. Mr. Pelrine surrendered himself at the station, and was processed on the above charges. He was released with a summons to appear in 4th District Court for arraignment on February 2nd, 2017, on the above charges.
7. **FELONY - Breaking & Entering a Building Misdemeanor: Vandalizing Alarm Box and Vandalism:** On Monday, January 2nd, 2017 at approximately 8:50 PM, Patrolmen Anthony Zoglio and Ryan Donohue arrested **Peter D. Graveline**, age 18, of 1018 Shannock Rd., Apt. A, Charlestown on charges of (1) **Breaking & Entering a Building with Felonious Intent (old Charbert's Mill)**, (2) **Vandalizing Alarm Box**, and (3) **Vandalism**, after officers responded to a burglary alarm that was activated in various parts of the commercial building at

299 Church Street that is formerly known as Charbert's Mill. Officers checked the interior of the building, and then met with the property manager. Suspects had pried open and damaged a window to make entry, and then deliberately damaged the building's security alarm box. Officers subsequently located male suspects in the area of the building property, and found them in possession of a police scanner. Mr. Graveline was processed at the station. He was arraigned before Justice of the Peace Joseph Scott, and was released on \$10,000 personal recognize on the above charges.

8. **FELONY - Breaking & Entering a Building Misdemeanor - Vandalism:** On Monday, January 2nd, 2017 at approximately 8:50 PM, Patrolmen Anthony Zoglio and Ryan Donohue arrested **Joseph F. Murray**, age 19, of 7 Willow Street, Hope Valley on charges of (1) **Breaking & Entering a Building with Felonious Intent (old Charbert's Mill)**, and (2) **Vandalism**, after officers responded to a burglary alarm that was activated in various parts of the commercial building at 299 Church Street that is formerly known as Charbert's Mill. Officers checked the interior of the building, and then met with the property manager. Suspects had pried open and damaged a window to make entry, and then deliberately damaged the building's security alarm box. Officers subsequently located male suspects in the area of the building property, and found them in possession of a police scanner. Mr. Murray was processed at the station. He was arraigned before Justice of the Peace Joseph Scott, and was released on \$10,000 personal recognize on the above charges.

Officers checked the interior of the building, and then met with the property manager. Suspects had pried open and damaged a window to make entry, and then deliberately damaged the building's security alarm box. Officers subsequently located male suspects in the area of the building property, and found them in possession of a police scanner. Mr. Salaun was processed at the station. He was arraigned before Justice of the Peace Joseph Scott, and was released on \$10,000 personal recognize on the above charges.
10. **DELINQUENT Juvenile - Breaking & Entering a Building / Wayward offense : Vandalism:** On Monday, January 2nd, 2017 at approximately 9:20 PM, Patrolmen Anthony Zoglio and Ryan Donohue arrested a **17-year-old juvenile male resident of Westerly** on charges of (1) **Breaking & Entering a Building with Felonious Intent (old Charbert's Mill)**, and (2) **Vandalism**, after officers responded to a burglary alarm that was activated in various parts of the commercial building at 299 Church Street that is formerly known as Charbert's Mill. Officers checked the interior of the building, and then met with the property manager. Suspects had pried open and damaged a window to make entry, and then deliberately damaged the building's security alarm box. Officers subsequently located male suspects in the area of the building property, and found them in possession of a

police scanner. The youth was released to his parent/guardian, and shall be petitioned into Family Court on the above charges.
