## PRESS RELEASE - July 5, 2017

---

1. **Misdemeanor - DUI (1<sup>st</sup> offense - BAC unknown) Operating on Suspended License (Certain Violations):** On Thursday, June 22, 2017, at 9:05 PM, Corporal William Litterio arrested **Donald E. Miller**, age 60, of 1655 Shannock Road, Charlestown on charges of (1) **Operating on a Suspended License - Certain Violations**, (2) **Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and/ or Drugs (1<sup>st</sup> offense - BAC unknown)**, and (3) **Refusal to Submit to a Chemical Test (civil)**, after a motor vehicle stop on South County Trail revealed that Mr. Miller's license to operate had been suspended in 2006 for *Refusal to Submit to a Chemical Test*. Mr. Miller was arrested on suspicion of DUI after performing a series of standard field sobriety tests. Mr. Miller was processed at the station, where he refused to consent to a chemical test. He was released with a summons to appear in 4<sup>th</sup> District Court for arraignment on the above charge.
2. **Misdemeanor - Operating on Suspended License (3<sup>rd</sup> Offense):** On Wednesday, June 28, 2017, at 12:00 AM, Patrolman Michael Jacome arrested **George H. Collins**, age 23, of 127 Smith Street, Cranston on a charge of **Operating on a Suspended License (3<sup>rd</sup> or subsequent suspended license violation)**, after a motor vehicle stop on Route 95 Northbound revealed that his license had been suspended on December 8, 2016, for *No Proof of Insurance*, and this constituted his third or subsequent suspended license violation. He was processed at the station, and was released with a summons to appear in 4<sup>th</sup> District Court on July 20, 2017 for arraignment on the above charge.
3. **Misdemeanor - Domestic Cyberstalking Prohibited:** On Wednesday, June 28, 2017, Detective Drew Bishop contacted the Cranston Police Department to request their assistance in serving a Richmond Police Department arrest warrant in their city. They subsequently arrested **Gabriel Frost**, age 42, of 82 Chestnut Avenue, Apt. 3, Cranston. At approximately 10:00 AM, Detective Bishop arrived at Cranston PD, and took custody of Mr. Frost on charges of **Domestic Cyberstalking Prohibited**, after an investigation into a citizen complaint revealed that between January and June 2017, Mr. Frost allegedly sent over 200 lascivious and unwelcome messages to the Facebook account of the victim. Mr. Frost was processed at the station, and was subsequently arraigned before Justice of the Peace Michael Robinson. Mr. Frost was released on \$1,000 personal recognizance and was ordered to have no-contact with the alleged victim.

4. **Misdemeanor - DUI (1<sup>st</sup> offense - BAC unknown):** On Saturday, July 1, 2017, at 10:00 PM, Patrolmen Daniel Kelley and Jeffrey Vaughn arrested **John E. Gardiner**, age 45, of 987 Main Street, Apt. B, Hopkinton on charges of (1) **Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and/ or Drugs (1<sup>st</sup> offense - BAC unknown)**, and (2) **Refusal to Submit to a Chemical Test (civil)**, after monitoring a radio broadcast regarding a 9-1-1 caller reporting an possible drunk driver on Route 112. As Patrolman Kelley proceeded south on Route 112 he observed a vehicle traveling north in the opposite direction drift across the solid yellow center line and nearly strike the front of his police cruiser. Officer Kelley subsequently turned around and stopped the vehicle on Route 112. Mr. Gardiner was arrested on suspicion of DUI after performing a series of standard field sobriety tests. Mr. Gardiner was processed at the station, where he refused to consent to a chemical test. He was released with a summons to appear in 4<sup>th</sup> District Court on July 13<sup>th</sup>, 2017 for arraignment on the above charge.
5. **Misdemeanor - DUI (1<sup>st</sup> offense - BAC unknown):** On Sunday, July 2, 2017, at 10:06 PM, Corporal William Litterio and Patrolmen Daniel Kelley arrested **Robert J. Stanko**, age 34, of 368 Church Street, Alton on charges of (1) **Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and/ or Drugs (1<sup>st</sup> offense - BAC unknown)**, and (2) **Refusal to Submit to a Chemical Test (civil)**, after Corporal Litterio stopped Mr. Stanko's vehicle on Church Street for speeding on Switch Road. Mr. Stanko was arrested on suspicion of DUI after performing a series of standard field sobriety tests. Mr. Stanko was processed at the station, where he refused to consent to a chemical test. He was released with a summons to appear in 4<sup>th</sup> District Court on July 20<sup>th</sup>, 2017, for arraignment on the above charge.
6. **Misdemeanor - Possession of Alcoholic Beverages by Underage Person:** On Tuesday, July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2017 at approximately 9:00 PM, Patrolman Ryan Donohue and Corporal William Litterio arrested **Jacob T. Beauregard**, age 18, of 8 Ridley Lane, Hope Valley on a charge of **Possession of Alcoholic Beverage by Underage Person**, after Officer Donohue stopped a vehicle for speeding on Kingstown Road, and discovered that the vehicle was occupied by three teenagers in possession of alcoholic beverages (beer and vodka). The operator of the vehicle, Mr. Beauregard, was processed at the station and was released with a summons to appear in 4<sup>th</sup> District Court on July 27<sup>th</sup>, 2017 for arraignment on the above charge. He was also cited with a civil violation for *Possession of Marijuana* (less than one ounce).
7. **Misdemeanor - Possession of Alcoholic Beverages by Underage Person:** On Tuesday, July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2017 at approximately 9:00 PM, Patrolman Ryan Donohue and Corporal William Litterio arrested **Bethan y L. Pagliarini**, age 19, of 10 Cedar Hills Drive, Wyoming on a charge of **Possession of Alcoholic Beverage by Underage Person**, after Officer Donohue stopped a vehicle for speeding on Kingstown Road, and discovered that the vehicle was occupied by three teenagers in possession of alcoholic beverages (beer and vodka). Ms. Pagliarini, a passenger, was processed at the station and was released with a summons to appear in 4<sup>th</sup> District Court on July 27<sup>th</sup>, 2017 for arraignment on the above charge.

8. **Misdemeanor – Possession of Alcoholic Beverages by Underage Person:** On Tuesday, July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2017 at approximately 9:00 PM, Patrolman Ryan Donohue and Corporal William Litterio arrested **Alyssa R. Bromley**, age 19, of 420 Carolina Back Road, Charlestown on a charge of **Possession of Alcoholic Beverage by Underage Person**, after Officer Donohue stopped a vehicle for speeding on Kingstown Road, and discovered that the vehicle was occupied by three teenagers in possession of alcoholic beverages (beer and vodka). Ms. Bromley, a passenger, was processed at the station and was released with a summons to appear in 4<sup>th</sup> District Court on July 27<sup>th</sup>, 2017 for arraignment on the above charge.
