PRESS RELEASE - November 16, 2016

1. **Misdemeanor- Shoplifting:** On Friday, November 11, 2016, at approximately 10:53 AM, Patrolmen Jeff Vaughn responded to the Westerly Police Department and took custody of **Ariel M. Ternes**, age 24, of 100 Oak Street, Westerly after Westerly Police arrested her on the strength of outstanding warrants, including an arrest warrant held by the Richmond Police Department charging her with **Shoplifting**. The charges stem from an investigation into a shoplifting incident that occurred on March 1st, 2016, at the Ocean State Job Lot in Wyoming, in which she and an accomplice allegedly entered the store together, and subsequently left the store parking lot in an awaiting vehicle with a stolen suitcase containing stolen merchandise. She was processed at the station, and was transported to the Women's Intake at the ACI on the strength of a separate bench warrant ordering that she be held without bail pending an appearance before the court.
2. **Misdemeanor - Willful Trespass, Disorderly Conduct, and Resisting Arrest:** On Saturday, November 12th, 2016 at approximately 5:30 PM, Patrolmen Anthony Zoglio and Michael Jacome arrested **Mary L. Cash**, age 46, of 1403 Victory Highway, Burrillville on charges of (1) **Willful Trespassing**, (2) **Disorderly Conduct**, and (3) **Resisting Arrest**, after officers were dispatched to 476 Gardiner Road for a 911-call reporting a domestic disturbance in progress. Ms. Cash had previously been served with a no-trespass order by the Richmond Police Department at the request of the property owner, who wished to have her removed. Ms. Cash reportedly refused to cooperate and became disruptive while actively resisting arrest. She was processed at the station. She was subsequently arraigned before Justice of the Peace James Callaghan, and was released on personal recognizance after being served with a no-contact order.
3. **Misdemeanor - Domestic Simple Assault & Battery and Domestic Disorderly Conduct:** On Saturday, November 12th, 2016 at approximately 5:40 PM, Patrolmen Anthony Zoglio and Michael Jacome arrested **John J. Burroughs**, age 55, of 476 Gardiner Road, Richmond, on charges of (1) **Domestic Simple Assault & Battery**, and (2) **Domestic Disorderly Conduct**, after officers were dispatched to that address for a 911-call reporting a domestic disturbance in progress. Officers observed a visible facial injury on the alleged victim, and arrested Mr. Burroughs without incident. He was processed at the station, and was arraigned before Justice of the Peace James Callaghan. He was subsequently released on personal recognizance, and was served with a no-contact order barring him from any contact with the alleged victim.

4. **Misdemeanor - DUI (1st offense - BAC .15 or greater):** On Sunday, November 13th, 2016 at approximately 1:39 AM, Patrolman Michael Jacome and Lieutenant John Arnold arrested **Lance A. Spears**, age 25, of 47A Kings Factory Road, Charlestown on a charge of **Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and/ or Drugs (1st offense - BAC .15)**, after Officers were dispatched to investigate a motor vehicle accident near 3897 South County Trail. Officers arrived to find that Mr. Spears had crashed into a guardrail. He was arrested on suspicion of DUI after performing a series of standard field sobriety tests, and submitted to a Breathalyzer test that resulted in BAC (blood-alcohol-content) readings of **.165 (1st phase)**, and **.167 (2nd phase)**. He was processed at the station and was later released to a sober adult with a summons to appear in 4th District Court for arraignment.
5. **Misdemeanor - Operating on a Suspended License (3rd Offense):** On Monday, November 15th, 2016, at approximately 10:47 AM, Patrolman Jeffrey Vaughn arrested **Joshua Moore**, age 43, of 59 Wayland Trail, Narragansett on a charge of **Operating on a Suspended License (3rd or subsequent offense)**, after a motor vehicle stop on Church Street revealed that his driver's license had been suspended that day for *Failure to Appear/Pay*. He was processed at the station, and was released with a summons to appear in 4th District Court on December 1st, 2016 for arraignment on the above charge.
