## **PRESS RELEASE - November 2, 2016**

---

1. **Wayward Juvenile - Simple Assault & Battery & Disorderly Conduct:** On Thursday, October 27<sup>th</sup>, 2016 at approximately 8:57 AM, School Resource Officer Adam Andrukiewicz arrested a **17 year-old male student** of the Chariho Regional High School on charges of (1) **Simple Assault and/or Battery** and (2) **Disorderly Conduct**, after an investigation into an alleged assault on a 14-year-old male student that occurred on Wednesday, October 26<sup>th</sup>, 2016, in the high school. Investigation revealed that the 17 year-old assailant allegedly placed the other student in a headlock and delivered several closed-fist punches to the victim's head. The youth shall be petitioned into Family Court on the above charges.
2. **Misdemeanor - Domestic Simple Assault & Domestic Disorderly Conduct:** On Friday, October 28<sup>th</sup>, 2016 at approximately 7:30 PM, Patrolmen Jeff Vaughn and Ryan Donohue arrested **Bernie Worden**, age 56, of 100 Shannock Village Road, Richmond on charges of (1) **Domestic Simple Assault**, and (2) **Domestic Disorderly Conduct**, after officers were dispatched to the above address for a 9-1-1 call regarding a domestic disturbance in progress. Mr. Worden was processed at the station, and was arraigned before Justice-of-the-Peace Michael Robinson. He was subsequently released on \$1,000 personal recognizance, and was served with a no-contact order barring him from any contact with his alleged victim.
3. **Wayward Juvenile - Simple Assault & Battery & Disorderly Conduct:** On Tuesday, November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016 at approximately 11:30 AM, School Resource Officer Adam Andrukiewicz arrested a **15-year-old male student** of the Chariho Regional High School on charges of (1) **Simple Assault and/or Battery** and (2) **Disorderly Conduct**, after an investigation into an alleged assault on a 16-year-old male student that occurred that morning in a school hallway. The assailant allegedly approached the other student in the hallway and without notice or provocation, delivered three closed-fist punches to the victim's face and head. The 15 year-old youth was turned over to his mother. He shall be petitioned into Family Court on the above charges.

4. **Fugitive from Justice (Sarasota, Florida):** On Tuesday, November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016 at approximately 5:50 PM, Corporal William Litterio arrested **Kurt E. Garlick**, age 42, of 370 Hillsdale Road, Apartment B, Richmond as a **Fugitive From Justice** after a stop of an unregistered motor vehicle on Hillsdale Road revealed that the male passenger, Mr. Garlick, had an outstanding arrest warrant in the State of Florida that had been issued on 9/7/16 by the **12<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit Court of Sarasota County**, Florida, charging him with *(1) Theft from person 65-years-old or older (valued at \$300 or more but less than \$10,000), and (2) Fraudulent Use of Personal Identity Information (2 counts)*. The State of Florida confirmed the warrant, and their intent to extradite Mr. Garlick back to their state to face the aforementioned charges. He was processed at the station and was subsequently transported to the Intake Service Center at the ACI. On the morning of November 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2016, he was arraigned in 4<sup>th</sup> District Court as a fugitive from justice, and waived extradition proceedings. He was remanded to the ACI where he shall be held without bail pending his return to the State of Florida.
