PRESS RELEASE - October 4, 2017

1. **WAYWARD Juvenile - Simple Assault & Battery:** On Monday, September 18th, 2017, at 2:49 PM, Patrolman Jeff Vaughn arrested a **16-year-old juvenile male student** of Chariho High School on a charge of **Simple Assault & Battery** after responding to investigate an incident in which the student allegedly waited in a hallway for another student to return to class, at which time he began punching the victim in the face/head. A teacher intervened to stop, and reported the matter to a dean of students. The youth was returned to the station where he was subsequently released to his mother. The youth shall be petitioned into Family Court on the above charges.
2. **WAYWARD Juvenile - Disorderly, Vandalism, and Simple Assault & Battery:** On Wednesday, September 20th, 2017, at 2:49 PM, Sergeant William Litterio and Patrolman Ryan Donohue arrested a **16-year-old juvenile male resident of Richmond** on charges of (1) **Disorderly Conduct**, (2) **Vandalism**, and (3) **Simple Assault & Battery** after officers were dispatched to a disturbance at the youth's home where he repeatedly punched holes in the drywall of the home's interior after his mother had removed a television from his room. When a guardian intervened to prevent further damage, the youth allegedly punched the victim in the face, and then ran outside and slashed a tire on the victim's car before fleeing the area on foot. Officers located the youth at a nearby property, and arrested him without incident. The youth was returned to the station where he was subsequently released to a grandparent. The youth shall be petitioned into Family Court on the above charges.
3. **Misdemeanor - Disorderly Conduct:** On Wednesday, September 20th, 2017, at 2:49 PM, Sergeant William Litterio and Patrolman Ryan Donohue arrested **Christopher Salisbury**, age 42, of 15 Weaver Lane, Burlington, VT on a charge of **Disorderly Conduct** after officers located the suspect at the Speedway gas station on Main Street. Prior to that, the department had received calls reporting that the subject had just been at the Richmond Mobil station demanding that customers give him a ride. When they refused, he reportedly became belligerent and profane with them. He then allegedly went to the Washington Trust Bank, where a patron reported that a belligerent and disheveled man was swearing and yelling at customers in the parking lot. Upon locating the subject at the Speedway, he was confrontational and belligerent with officers and refused to leave the area peacefully. He was arrested and was subsequently processed at the station. He was released with a summons to appear in 4th District Court for arraignment on the above charge.

4. **WAYWARD Juvenile - Simple Assault & Battery:** On Friday, September 22, 2017, at 2:03 PM, School Resource Officer Adam Andrukiewicz arrested a **15-year-old juvenile male student** of Chariho RYSE Program on a charge of **Disorderly Conduct** after responding to investigate an incident in which the student allegedly disrupted classes and engaged in a verbal tirade directed at staff, threatening to assault them. The youth was returned to the station where he was subsequently released to an authorized guardian. The youth shall be petitioned into Family Court on the above charge.
5. **Bench Warrants:** On Thursday, September 28th, 2017 at approximately 7:51 PM, Patrolman Ryan Donohue arrested **Dennis M. Kenyon**, age 28, of 38 Sagamore Drive, Charlestown on the strength of three outstanding bench warrants including: an outstanding **Washington County Superior Court Bench Warrant (hold without bail)** that had been issued on August 6, 2015, for *Failure to Appear - Cost Review* on an original felony conviction of *Possession of a Schedule I Controlled Substance* (Richmond Police Department); an outstanding **4th District Court Bench Warrant** that had been issued on September 24, 2015, for *Failure to Appear - Ability to Pay* on an original conviction of *Driving without a License* (South Kingstown Police Department); and on an outstanding **Family Court Reciprocal Body Attachment** that had been issued on April 8, 2016, for *Failure to Pay Child Support*. Officer Donohue conducted a motor vehicle stop on South County Trail and the operator's license was expired. He then discovered that the passenger, Mr. Kenyon, was wanted on the above warrants. Mr. Kenyon was processed at the station, and was then transported to the ACI's Intake Service Center on the strength of the above court warrants pending his appearance in court.
6. **Misdemeanor - DUI (1st offense - BAC greater than .15):** On Friday, September 29, 2017 at approximately 10:05 PM, Patrolmen Adam Andrukiewicz and Jeff Vaughn arrested **Jamie E. Foster**, age 22, of 3 Lisa Lane, Hopkinton on a charge of **Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and/ or Drugs (1st offense - BAC greater than .15)**, after a 9-1-1 caller reported an erratic vehicle leaving traveling in an easterly direction on Main Street, repeatedly weaving and driving up onto the sidewalk, and then accelerating to excessive speeds on Route 138. The Good Samaritan followed the vehicle to Blue Ribbon Drive where the operator stopped the vehicle, and the police arrived on scene, one of whom had been assigned to a grant-funded *Impaired Driving Enforcement* detail sponsored by the **Rhode Island Department of Transportation**. The operator, Ms. Foster, was arrested on suspicion of DUI after performing a series of standard field sobriety tests. Once at the station, she submitted to a Breathalyzer test that resulted in BAC (blood-alcohol-content) readings of **.249 (1st phase)**, and **.237 (2nd phase)**. She was processed and released with a summons to appear in 4th District Court for arraignment on the above charge.

7. **FELONY - Possession of a Controlled Substance (Cocaine):** On Saturday, September 30th, 2017 at 9:30 PM, Sergeant William Litterio and Lieutenant John Arnold arrested **Kevin Delgado**, age 20, of 20 Branch Street, South Kingstown on a charge of **Possession of a Controlled Substance (Cocaine)**, after Sgt. Litterio happened upon a vehicle parked in the northbound travel lane of Heaton Orchard Road, and discovered two male occupants. Sgt. Litterio saw the passenger discard something near the floor. Officers subsequently discovered a folded dollar bill that contained approximately nine (9) grams of a powdery white substance (cocaine). Mr. Delgado was processed at the station and was released with a summons to appear in 4th District Court for arraignment on the above charge.

8. **Misdemeanor - DUI (1st offense - BAC unknown):** On Monday, October 2, 2017, 2017, at 10:42 PM, Patrolman Adam Andrukiewicz arrested **Donald B. Lewis, Jr.**, age 27, of 53 Ashaway Road, Westerly, on charges of (1) **Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and/ or Drugs (1st offense - BAC unknown)**, (2) **Refusal to Submit to a Chemical Test (civil)**, and (3) **Operating a Suspended License (1st offense - civil violation)** after stopping his vehicle leaving the lane of travel and sideswiping a curb on Main Street. Mr. Lewis was arrested on suspicion of DUI after performing a series of standard field sobriety tests, and was processed at the station. He refused to consent to a chemical test, and was subsequently released with a summons to appear in 4th District Court for arraignment on the above charges.
