PRESS RELEASE - September 21, 2017

- 1. Bench Warrant:** On September 12th, 2017, at approximately 5:22 PM, Patrolman Daniel Kelley arrested **Alex D. Shea**, age 24, of 514 Old Carolina Backroad, Charlestown on the strength of a **District Court Bench Warrant** issued on September 08, 2017 for *Failure to Appear for Pretrial* on an original charge of *DUI* (Westerly P.D.). The arrest stemmed from a motor vehicle stop on Main Street. Mr. Shea was transported to the Richmond Police Station for processing and then transported to Adult Correctional Institution Intake Service Center.
- 2. Wayward Juvenile-Obstructing a Police Officer:** On September 14, 2017 at approximately 8:08 AM, School Resource Officer (SRO) Adam Andrukiewicz arrested a **15 year old male student** at the Chariho High School on a charge of *Obstructing a Police Officer in Execution of Duty* after he obstructed the (SRO) while he conducted an investigation. The juvenile was transported to the station for processing and turned over to a guardian. The juvenile will be petitioned into Family Court on the above charge.
- 3. Misdemeanor - DUI (1st Offense-BAC Unknown):** On September 14, 2017 at approximately 11:39 PM, Sergeant William Litterio and Patrolman Andy Briody arrested **Hannah Faucher**, age 27 of 220 Carolina Nooseneck Road, Richmond on charges of (1) **Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and/or Drugs (1st offense-BAC Unknown)**, and (2) **Refusal to Submit to a Chemical Test (civil)**, after investigating a motor vehicle in the rear parking lot of a closed business on Kingstown Road. Ms. Faucher was arrested on suspicion of DUI after performing a series of standardized field sobriety tests. She was returned to the station where she refused to consent to a chemical test. She was processed and released on a summons to appear in 4th District Court for arraignment on the above charge.
- 4. Misdemeanor's-Operating With a Suspended License and Disorderly Conduct:** On September 16th, 2017 at approximately 8:52 PM, Patrolmen Ryan Donohue and Daniel Kelley arrested **Thomas Lemoi**, age 39 of 200 Wakefield Street, West Warwick for **(1) Operating on a suspended License** and **(2) Disorderly Conduct**. The arrest occurred after Mr. Lemoi's vehicle was

stopped on Nooseneck Hill Road after police received a complaint that the operator had been causing a disturbance at a local Main Street business. During the course of the investigation it was also determined that Mr. Lemoi's operator license had been suspended on July 01, 2016. Mr. Lemoi was transported to the Richmond Police station for processing and was released with a District Court Summons to appear on October 19, 2017 to answer to the above charges.

5. **Misdemeanor-Disorderly Conduct:** On September 16, 2017 Patrolmen Ryan Donohue and Daniel Kelley arrested **Andrew A. Bequette** age 35 of 200 Wakefield Street, West Warwick on a charge of **Disorderly Conduct**. The arrest stemmed from a complaint of a disturbance at a Main Street business in which he was an involved participant. Mr. Bequette was returned to the police station where he was processed and released on a summons to appear in Fourth District Court for arraignment on the above charge on October 19, 2017.

6. **Misdemeanor- DUI (1st Offense -BAC unknown):** On September 17, 2017 at approximately 6:14 PM Patrolman Jeffrey Vaughn arrested Gregory K. Chandler age 47 of 58 Kenney Drive, Thomaston CT on charges of (1) **Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and/or Drugs (1st offense-BAC Unknown)**, and (2) **Refusal to Submit to a Chemical Test (civil)**. The arrest was the result of a 911 call from a motorist reporting a vehicle operating erratically on Kingstown Road crossing the centerline of travel and forcing vehicles to the shoulder of the travel lane. Mr. Chandler was arrested on suspicion of DUI after being unable to perform standardized field sobriety test's. He was returned to the station where he refused to consent to a chemical test and was released on a summons to appear in 4th District Court for arraignment on the above charge on October 5th 2017.
